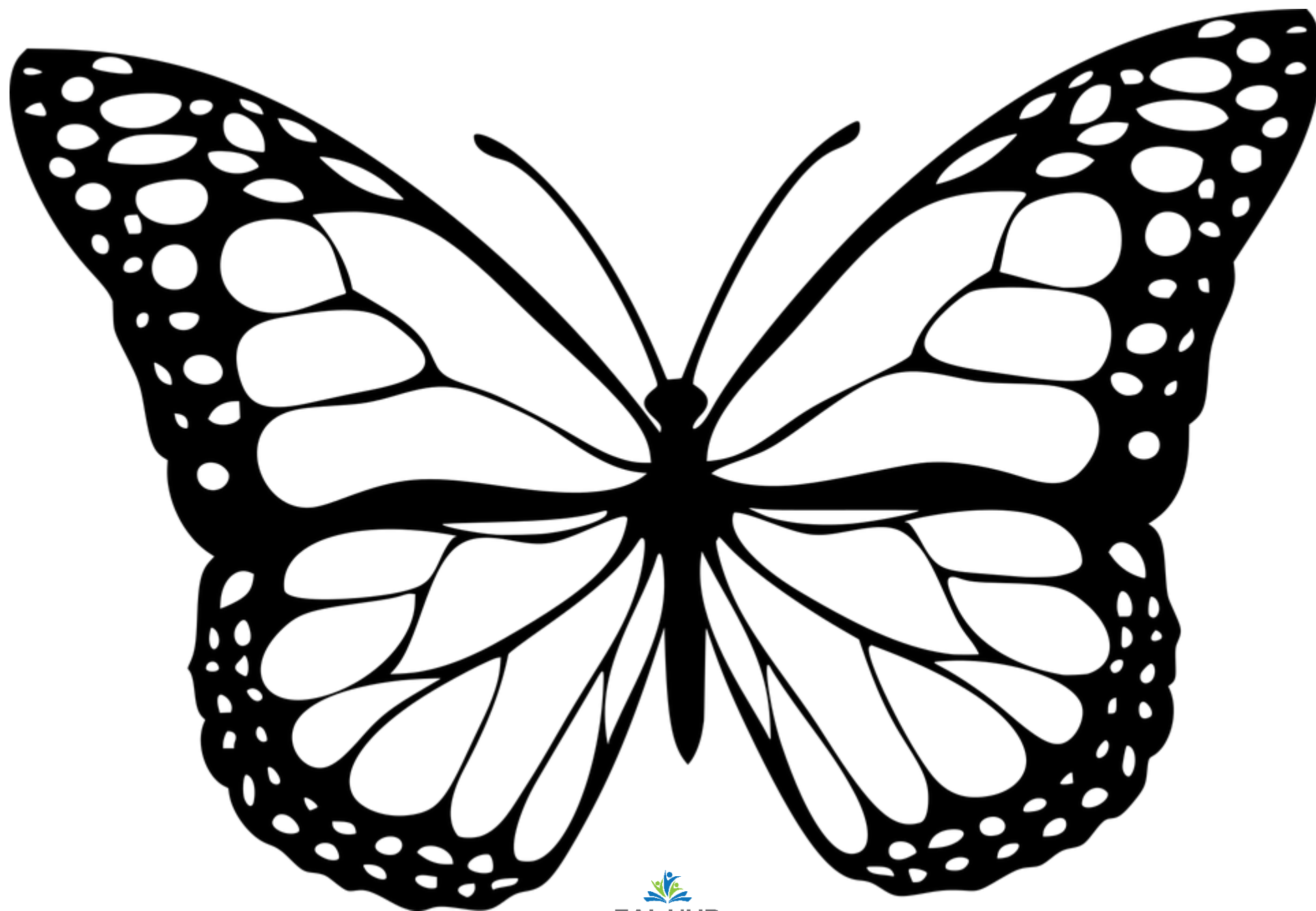


Design some shoes for this caterpillar and then colour him in!




Butterflies are symmetrical – this means they are the same on both wings.

Can you design a beautiful butterfly?




