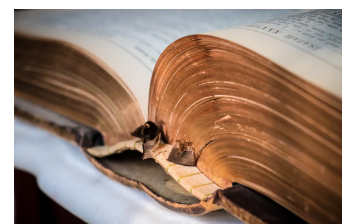
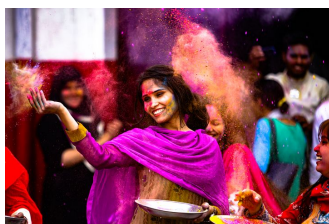





Read the text and then answer the questions below
